Dear Congresswoman Blunt Rochester,

The Delaware Healthcare Association (DHA) recognizes that obesity negatively affects quality of life and increases the risk that an individual will develop one or more associated diseases. Obesity increases the risk of impairment, illness, premature death, and inability to enjoy fully otherwise normal and expected life activities assumed absent obesity.

Therapeutic treatment, procedures, and pharmacological interventions to combat obesity in patients. Our member hospitals and associated clinicians offer a range of treatments to address obesity issues and assist patients with weight reduction and management.

Cost of treatment and lack of insurance coverage can affect access to these potentially lifesaving and life enhancement interventions to address obesity in individuals.

DHA is pleased to support H.R. 1577, the Treat and Reduce Obesity Act (TROA). We understand TROA will:

- (1) Expand Medicare benefits for intensive behavioral counseling through community-based programs and additional types of healthcare providers, including: dietitians, psychologists and specialty physicians.
- (2) Expand coverage of FDA-approved prescription drugs for chronic weight management.

We support H.R. 1577 with the understanding that additional financial support would pay for implementation of TROA, as opposed to financing TROA through reduction in other existing Medicare programs. Too often we have witnessed desirable Medicare expansion proposed to be financed with redirection of existing Medicare program support, in an attempt to maintain budget neutrality. These types of schemes deprive others of health care access and must be avoided.

We are pleased to support H.R. 1577 and ask you to consider supporting this initiative.
